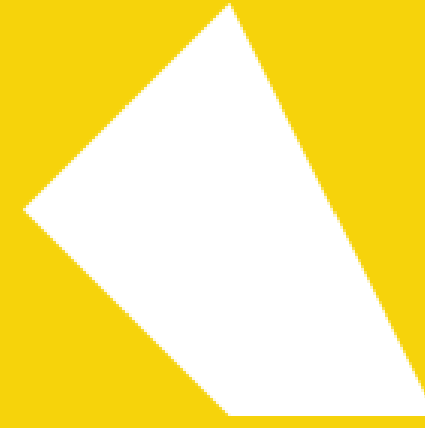
Priorities and progress

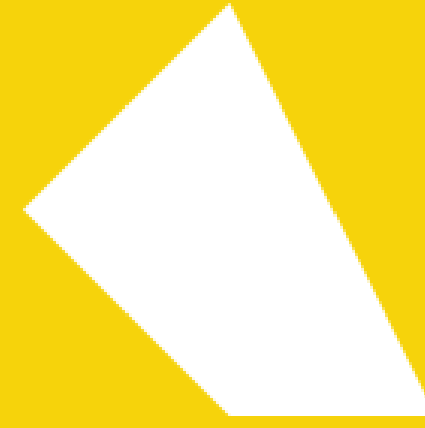

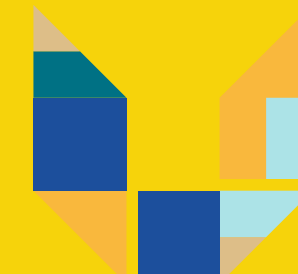
