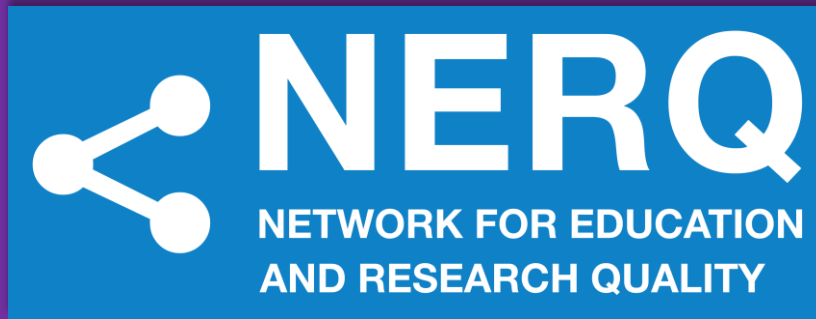

# What NERQ has accomplished



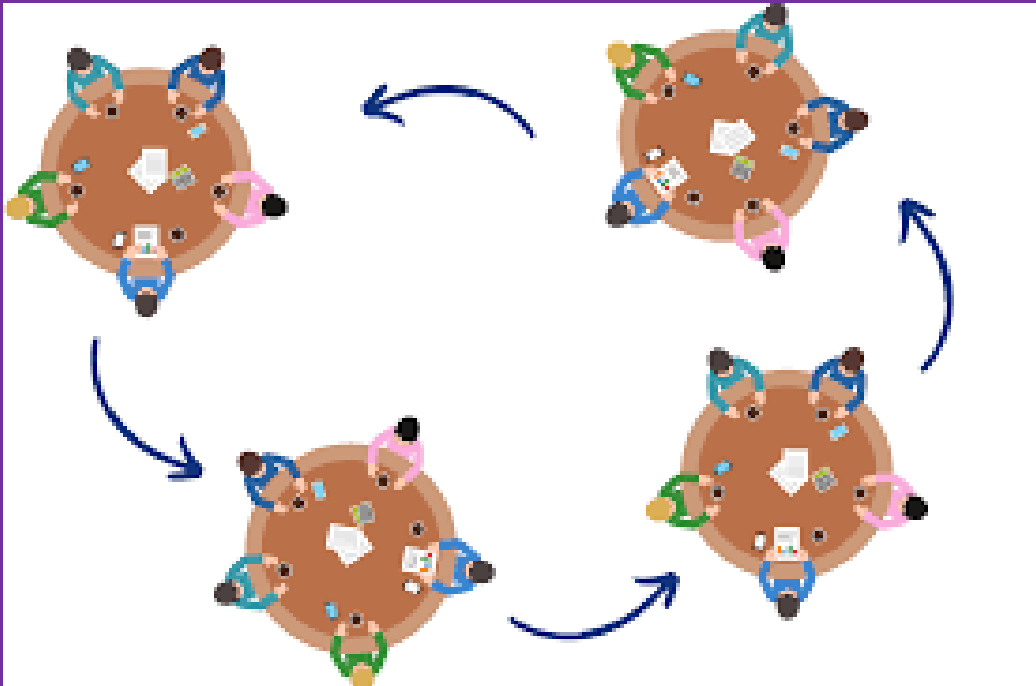
- Support from the EU on the initiative

# The World Cafe Method

Round 3: barriers and carriers (how to move forward...)

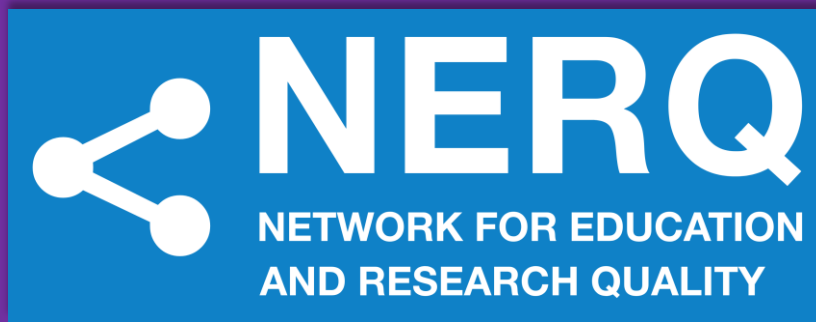
# Discussion points (tables)



1. (on trainer capacity in RCR training): the trainer capacity and trainer quality is poor at the moment. Certified trainings should become more available.
2. (on researchers' RCR capacities): Many RI trainings still focus on compliance with regulations, not on capacity building and it is unlikely this will change in the near future?
3. (on RCR and global perspective): Trainings in RCR are too homogeneous (one of a kind) so far. We need to take better into account the differences between disciplines, countries, cultures in research.
4. (on the future of RCR training): Current training offers on RI, RE, OS and RRI should all be united in one clear offer to researchers and (PhD) students. Otherwise, some types of trainings will never reach their target groups.
5. (on inclusive trainings) Most RCR trainings lack tailoring to specific groups and their needs and are not paying attention to diversity and inclusiveness.
6. (on dominance) RCR trainings should be available around the world: networks like NERQ have the moral obligation to share knowledge and expertise.

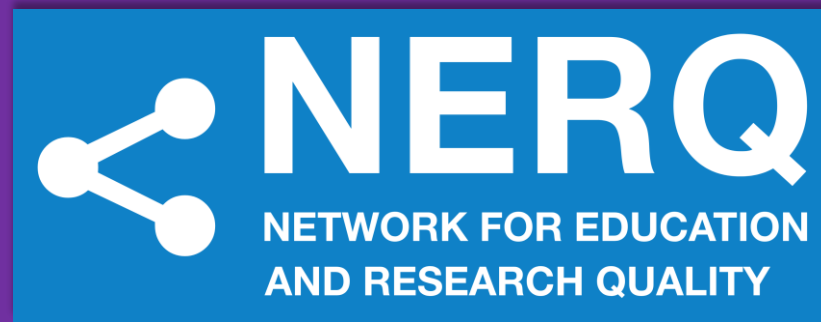
